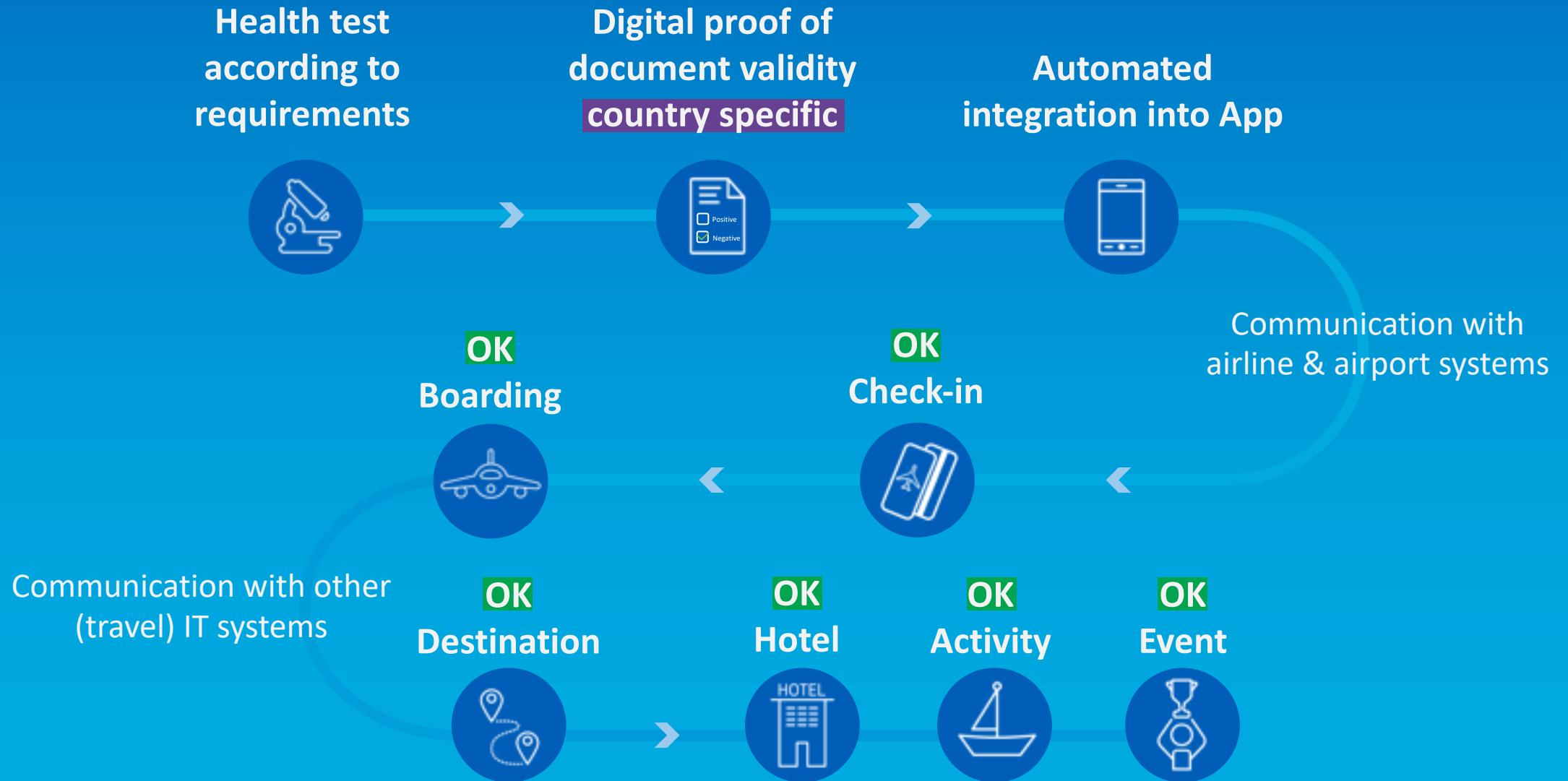

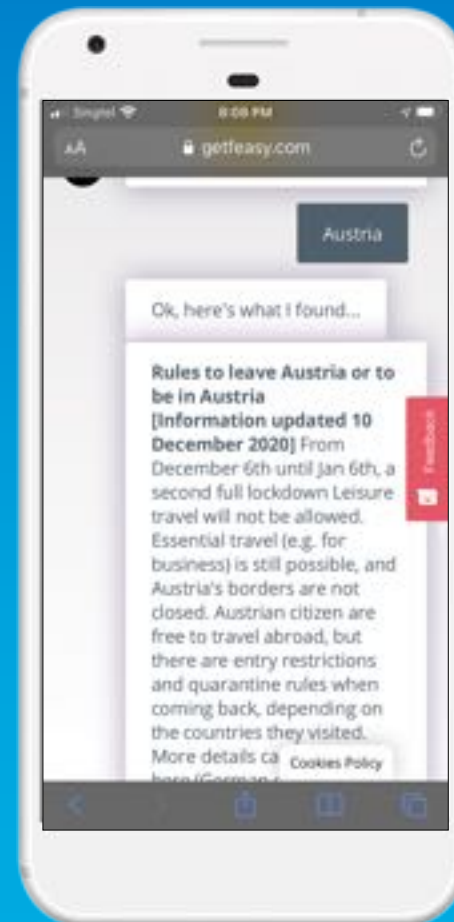
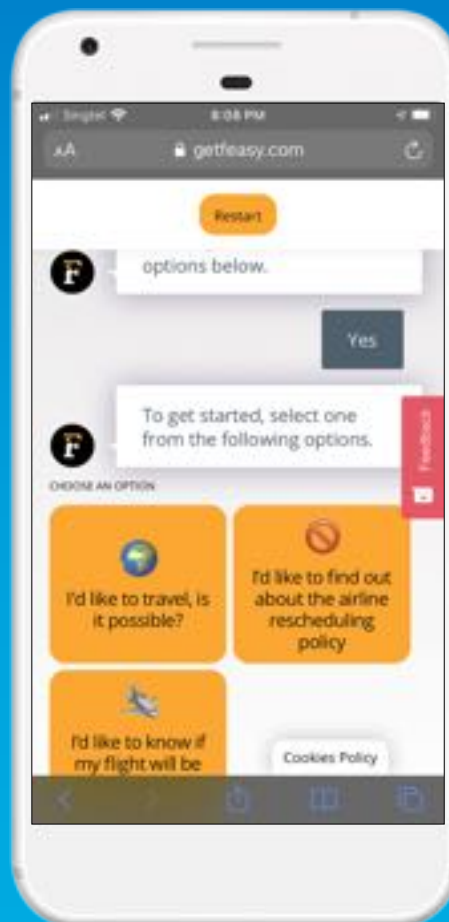
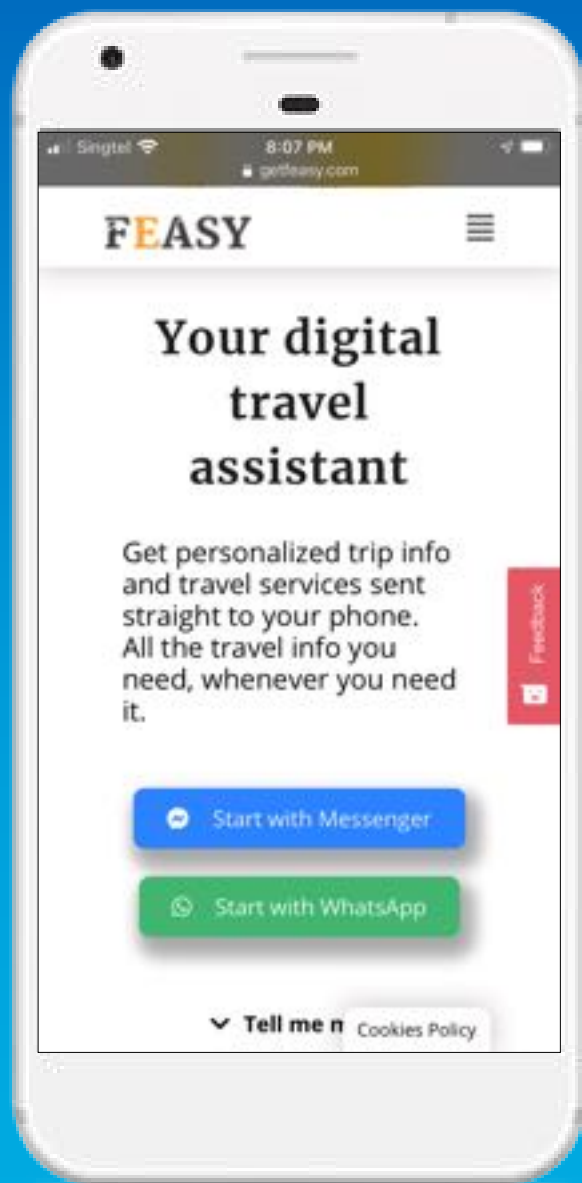


EU Traffic Light System





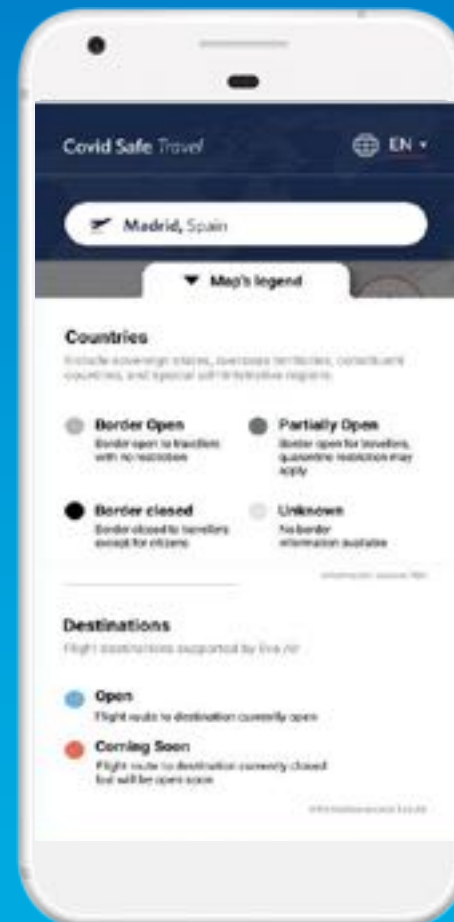
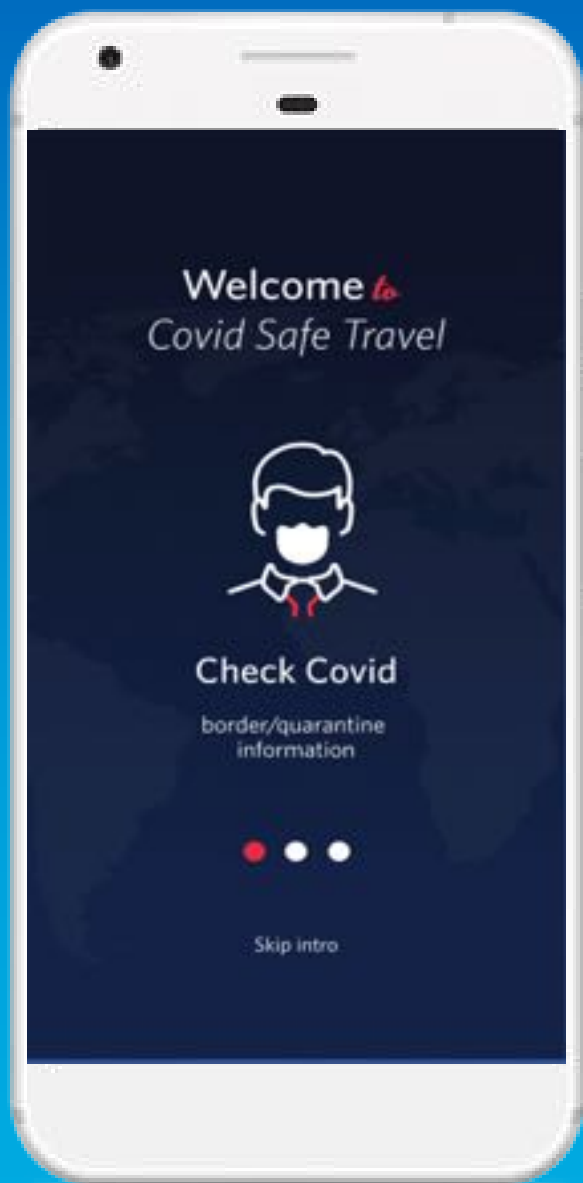
